ASH WEDNESDAY: Wednesday, 25 February 2009, begins the Season of Lent which ends on the afternoon of Holy Thursday, 9 April 2009.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE: Ash Wednesday, (25 February) and Good Friday, (10 April) are days of total abstinence from meat and also days of fast, that is, limited to a single full meal. All the Fridays of Lent are days of total abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics over 14 years of age; the law of fasting binds all Catholics from the 18th year until and including their 59th birthday.

HAIL, QUEEN OF HEAVEN: The Marian antiphon, *Ave Regina Caelorum*, is sung from the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord until Holy Thursday. At Visitation Parish, it is one of the four traditional Marian antiphons sung during the presentation of the gifts.

SAINTS/WINDOWS: 3 March, Katherine Drexel (1958 – 1955) Katherine Drexel was born in Philadelphia. An heiress to a large fortune, she sought to help educate Native and African Americans. In 1891 she founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament. Their logo appears in the upper panel. These sisters staffed missions and schools throughout the United States. She founded the only Catholic University for African Americans, Xavier University in New Orleans. Its insignia appears in the lower panel.

For safety reasons: Faith Formation sessions are cancelled if a snow emergency plan is in effect, or if Montgomery County public schools are closed for school/community use; the parish office is open if there is a delay in the opening of schools; the office is closed if schools are closed; and weekday liturgy is held if there is a delay in the opening of schools; if schools are closed, there is no weekday liturgy.

Finance

MORTGAGE: As of 1 February 2009, our mortgage debt is \$779,835.47. Our monthly interest/payment is \$18,500. The January income from our Debt Reduction collection amounted to \$6,350.74.
