FAST AND ABSTINENCE: Abstinence from meat (beast or fowl) is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on all Fridays of Lent. This obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products, or condiments of any kind, even though made from animal fat. Fasting means to limit oneself to one full meal on a given fast day. Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 are obliged to fast on Good Friday, 10 April 2009. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength. However, the two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Moreover, eating solid foods between meals on fast days is not permitted. However, liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed. Self-imposed observance of fasting on all weekdays of Lent is strongly recommended.

SACRAMENT OF PENANCE/RECONCILIATION: During Lent, the Sacrament of Penance/reconciliation will be celebrated Wednesday evenings from 6:30pm to 8:00pm in the church.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Fridays through 3 April, 7:00pm in the church.

LITURGICAL MINISTERS: The March/April/May Liturgy schedule has been mailed. Please let the parish office know if you have not received your schedule. Included with the mailing was an availability sheet for Holy Week, Triduum and Confirmation. Please return that special availability sheet by Monday, 16 March 2009.

HAIL, QUEEN OF HEAVEN: The Marian antiphon, *Ave Regina Caelorum*, is sung from the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord until Holy Thursday. At Visitation Parish, it is one

of the four traditional Marian antiphons sung during the presentation of the gifts.

NEW ALTAR SERVER TRAINING: Youth in grades 4 and up who would like to become altar servers are invited to a training session on Saturday, 21 March, at 10:00am. A parent/guardian must accompany his/her child. Training will last approximately one and one-half hour.
