SALVE REGINA: The Marian antiphon, *Salve Regina*, is sung from Trinity Sunday to the First Sunday of Advent. It was used as a processional chant at Cluny as early as 1135. The text of the antiphon is the familiar prayer, “*Hail, Holy Queen.*” At Visitation Parish we use it as a processional chant during the presentation of the gifts.

SAINTS/WINDOWS: 30 June, Pierre Toussaint (1766 - 1853) Pierre Toussaint was born a slave in Haiti (upper panel). Jean and Marie Berard brought him to New York City in 1787, where he became a hairdresser. He attended Mass daily. With Elizabeth Ann Seton, he founded one of New York City’s first orphanages, and he helped raise funds for the city’s first cathedral. In 1990, John Cardinal O’Connor moved his remains to the crypt beneath the high altar of St. Patrick’s Cathedral (lower panel).
