**SNOW EMERGENCY:** While it is not our practice to cancel Mass, dangerous travel/road conditions are legitimate reasons that might prevent an individual from fulfilling the Sunday obligation to attend Mass. Those who cannot safely travel to attend mass in person are encouraged to watch the Sunday TV Mass, which airs at 10:30am on CW50.

**LENT:** The Lenten season has a double character, namely to prepare both perspective Catholics and parishioners to celebrate the paschal mystery. The perspective Catholics, both with the rite of election and scrutinies, and by catechesis, are prepared for the celebration of the sacraments of Christian initiation; the parishioners, ever more attentive to the word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises (*Caeremoniale episcoporum*, 249). Lent runs from Ash Wednesday (17 February 2010) until the Mass of the Lord's Supper exclusive on Holy Thursday (1 April 2010).

**FAST AND ABSTINENCE:** Abstinence from meat (beast or fowl) is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on all Fridays of Lent. This obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products, or condiments of any kind, even though made from animal fat. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal on a given fast day. Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 are obliged to fast on Good Friday, 2 April 2010. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength. However, the two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Moreover, eating solid foods between meals on fast days is not permitted. However, liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed. Self-imposed observance of fasting on all weekdays of Lent is strongly recommended.

**SACRAMENT OF PENANCE/RECONCILIATION:** During Lent, the Sacrament of Penance/Reconciliation will be celebrated Wednesday evenings, 24 February - 24 March, from 6:30pm to 8:00pm in the church. Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament will take place during that time.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS:** Fridays, through 26 March, 7:00pm in the church.

**IN/OUT OF FLU SEASON –** No one is ever under an obligation to shake hands during the Sign of Peace (a statement of peace, bow or other gesture is appropriate) or to receive from the chalice. Christ is fully present in each species when the bread and wine have been consecrated into His Body and Blood. Anyone who is ill, or suspects he or she is ill, should refrain from receiving from the chalice out of good will. Also, he or she may wish to receive the host in the hand rather than by the mouth. Common sense dictates one remain at home if feeling unwell.

**HAIL, QUEEN OF HEAVEN:** The Marian antiphon, *Ave Regina Caelorum*, is sung from the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord until Holy Thursday. At Visitation Parish, it is one of the four traditional Marian antiphons sung during the presentation of gifts.

**SAINTS/WINDOWS: 3 March, Katherine Drexel (1858 – 1955)** Katherine Drexel was born in Philadelphia. An heiress to a large fortune, she sought to help educate native and African Americans. In 1891, she founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament. Their logo appears in the upper panel. These sisters staffed missions and schools throughout the United States. She founded the only Catholic University for African Americans, Xavier University in New Orleans. Its insignia appears in the lower panel.

**SNOW EMERGENCY:** It is not our practice to cancel Liturgy on Sundays and on Holy Days of Obligation, including their vigils, because of weather. Faith Formation sessions are cancelled if a snow emergency plan is in effect, or if Montgomery Country public schools are closed for school/community use. The parish office is open if there is a delay in the opening of schools; the office is closed if schools are closed. Weekday liturgy is held if there is a delay in the opening of schools. **SNOWFALL SHORTFALL:** Our parish is under budget because of lower attendance and the cost of snow removal. We are grateful to those parishioners who make up/increase their contributions.

**MORTGAGE:** As of 1 February 2010, our monthly mortgage debt is \$598,417.55. The January revenue amounted to \$9,347.33. Our monthly interest/principal payment is \$18,500. (Our original loan amounted to \$2,220,000.)
