**SOLEMNITY OF ALL SAINTS:** Sacred Liturgy will be celebrated on **Tuesday, 01 November** at 12:00 noon and at 7:00 p.m. in the Church.



**ALL SOULS DAY:** Sacred Liturgy will be celebrated on **Wednesday, 02 November**, at 9:15 a.m. in the St. Thomas More Chapel in the Barn.

**ROMAN MISSAL REVISED:** The third edition of the Roman Missal will be inaugurated on the First Sunday of Advent 2011. Our current English translation dates to 1973. The new translation will use language that is more biblical and more in keeping with the translation of the Revised Lectionary. **SAINTS/WINDOWS: 13 November, Frances Xavier Cabrini** (1850 – 1917). Frances Xavier Cabrini was born in San Angelo, Italy. She founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart and established dozens of schools, hospitals and orphanages throughout the United States and South America. While on a picnic in Colorado with orphaned children, she had them gather rocks and construct a large image of the Sacred Heart (upper panel). Mother Cabrini believed that each of us is called to carry the gospel message to others, and that Mary, Star of the Sea, guides us to where we are most needed (lower panel).

**18 November, Rose Philippine Duchesne** (1769 – 1852): Rose Philippine Duchesne was born in Grenoble, France in 1769 and entered the Visitation Order at nineteen. After the community was dispersed by the French Revolution, Rose joined St. Madeleine Sophie Barat in her newly founded Society of the Sacred Heart (upper panel). She led a pioneer band of nuns to Missouri, opened schools and worked in Sugar Creek, Kansas. The Potawatomi, Indians called her “Woman who prays always.” One night the children placed small feathers on her veil as she knelt in prayer. In the morning, the feathers had not moved (lower panel). She died in 1852 and was canonized in 1988. In the United States her feast day is 18 November.

**ALL SOULS’ DAY AT CATHOLIC CEMETERIES:** Wednesday, **02 November**, All Souls’ Day, is the day the Church has set aside to commemorate deceased family members and loved ones. Parishioners are encouraged to make a special visit to pray for their departed loved ones. Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 a.m. in the chapel at Gate of Heaven Cemetery in Silver Spring, Mt.
